What cookies are and how they are used

As part of offering and providing customizable and personalized services, Virtually Cuba may use [cookies](#) to store and sometimes track information about you. A cookie is a small amount of data that is sent to your browser from a web server and stored on your computer's hard drive. Certain features of Virtually Cuba require that you accept cookies in order to work properly. Who is collecting your information

When you are asked for personal information on Virtually Cuba, you are sharing that information with Virtually Cuba alone, unless it is specifically stated otherwise. For example, when you enter personal information on the ad posting form, this information will generally be included in your ad, unless specifically stated otherwise.

With whom your information may be shared

As a general rule, Net Engineers, Inc. will not disclose any of your personally identifiable information except when we have your permission or under special circumstances, such as when we believe in good faith that the law requires it or under the circumstances described below. Net Engineers, Inc. may disclose account information in special cases when we have reason to believe that disclosing this information is necessary to identify, contact or bring legal action against someone who may be violating the Terms of Service of the Net Engineers, Inc. or may be causing injury to or interference with (either intentionally or unintentionally) the rights or property of the Net Engineers, Inc., other users of the Net Engineers, Inc., or anyone else that could be harmed by such activities. Net Engineers, Inc. may disclose or access account information when we believe in good faith that the law requires it and for administrative and other purposes that we deem necessary to maintain, service, and improve our products and services.

What choices are available to you regarding collection, use, and distribution of your information

If you choose not to provide personal information, you can still use some areas of Virtually Cuba, but you will not be able to access areas or use features that require you to submit personal information, such as posting ads.

You also have choices with respect to cookies. By modifying your browser preferences, you have the choice to accept all cookies, to be notified when a cookie is set, or to reject all cookies. If you choose to reject all cookies you will be unable to use those services of Virtually Cuba that require registration in order to participate. You can still use most of the features of Virtually Cuba even if you do not accept cookies.

The Net Engineers, Inc. does not sell or rent user information to anyone. We will notify you at the time of data collection or transfer if your data will be shared with a third party and you will always have the option of not permitting the transfer. If you do not wish to allow your data to be shared, you can choose not to use a particular service.
